Small Town Librarian Awarded Stipend for Texas Library Association Conference

Small Community Library Round Table selects recipient of Biblionix sponsored stipend

Austin, Texas - March 21, 2008 - The Small Community Library Round Table (SCLRT) of the Texas Library Association (TxLA) today announced its selection for the recipient of the Biblionix stipend. The stipend of \$500 is offered annually to a single SCLRT member and employee in a small public library in Texas. It is offered to defray costs for attending the TxLA annual conference. The 2008 conference is in Dallas on April 15-18. This year's stipend winner is Adrienne Montgomery of the San Augustine Public Library in San Augustine, Texas. Her application was seconded by a letter from the San Augustine City Manager, James Lyons, Jr.

"I'm delighted to be the recipient of this year's Biblionix stipend," said Ms. Montgomery. "Without it, I could not attend the conference. I appreciate this opportunity very much and intend to use it to focus on the areas of library administration, materials selection for specific populations, technological advancements, program development, disaster planning, and research tools and methods."

Ms. Montgomery is the director of her small rural library, which is the only library in San Augustine County. Per the terms of the stipend, Ms. Montgomery is required to volunteer for 4 hours at the conference, including 2 hours at the SCLRT booth. Also, she must attend the SCLRT functions as well as obtain a minimum of 8 CE credits.
