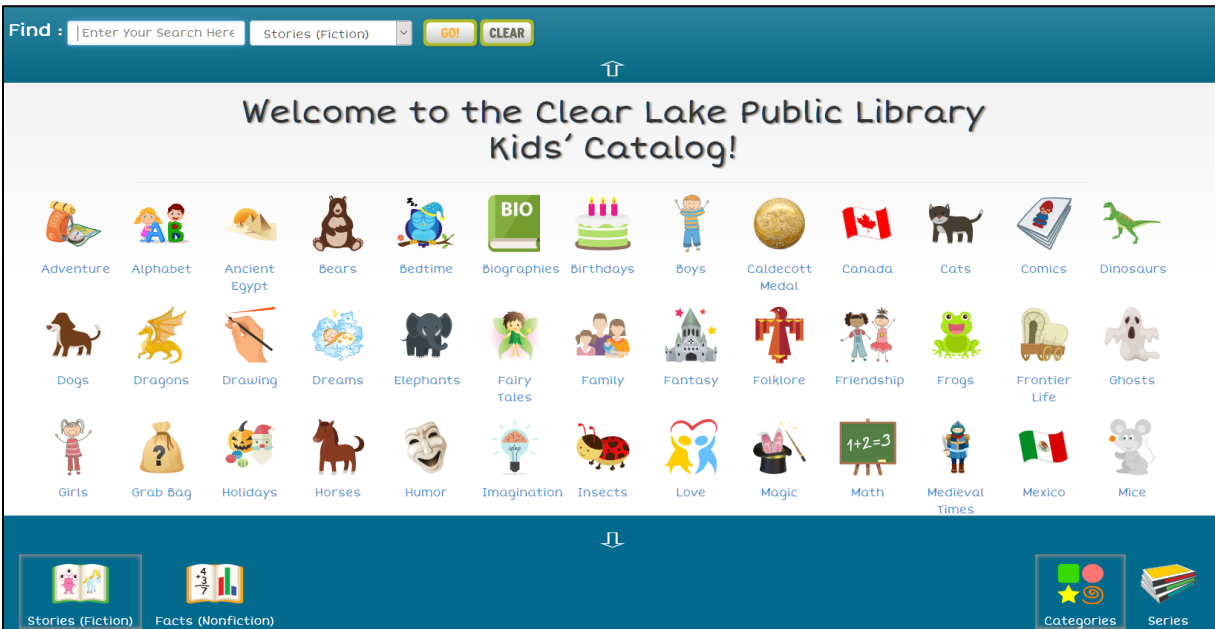


Apollo Kids' Catalog

Apollo now has a catalog dedicated to your elementary school-aged patrons. Below is a screen grab example of the main page. [And here's an example Kids' Catalog.](#)



To keep it simple, there is no log-in capability. And you decide which materials are represented by selecting individual material types.

There is a fee for adding the Kids' Catalog to your account. It's an annual fee of 20 percent of your Apollo annual fee. We can enable it for you at any time. We'll add the prorated amount to your account, so you won't be billed until your normal billing cycle.

Once we've enabled the Kids' Catalog for you, here's how to get it set up!

- 1) **Choosing materials:** The Kids' Catalog needs to know which material types to include. You can select these in Setup | Material Types.

Find the desired types and click the Edit button. There you'll see these two options:

- 2) **URL for Kids' Catalog:** In the Apollo Main Console, you'll see a new link to the Kids' Catalog. To obtain the URL for using in your search terminals or in emails, etc., you can click this new link and copy the URL from the address bar or you can right-click and then choose "Copy Link Location."

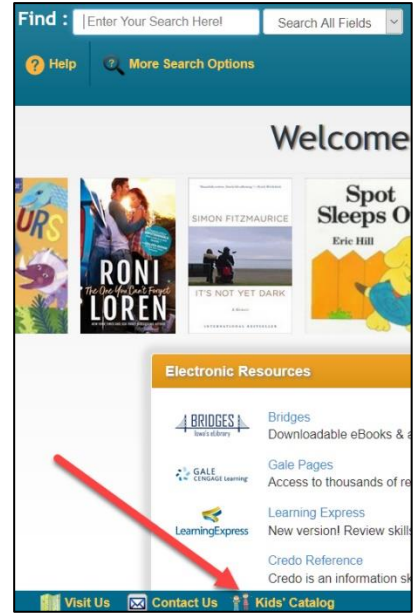

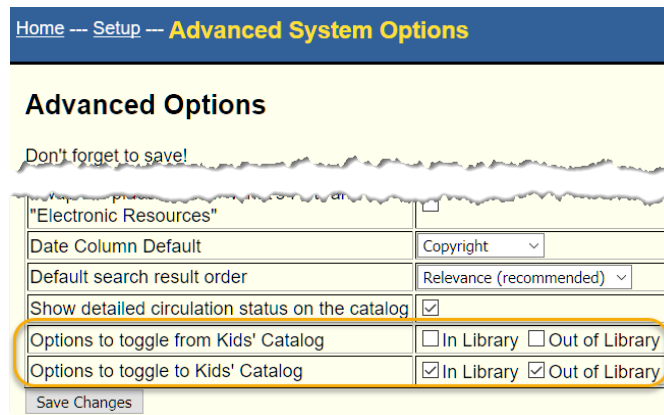

3) **Toggle/linking between the two catalogs:** With two catalogs available, you may wish to manage navigation between them. For example, you may decide to have a PC in the library dedicated to the Kids' Catalog with no link to the general catalog. There is an option for that as well as the alternate case: to show or not show a Kids' Catalog link in the general catalog. In addition, there are related options to display or not display such links depending upon whether or not the patron is inside the library building (see below for what "inside the library" means).



These choices can be made in Setup | Advanced System Options. The conditions shown below are the defaults. These defaults will show a link from the general catalog to the Kids' Catalog both inside and outside of the library and no link from the Kids' Catalog back to the general catalog.



Note: The "inside the library" designation is achieved by the IP address settings at the very bottom of your Setup | Passwords page. Any IP address listed in the "Library IP Address(es)" field is considered to be inside the library building.
